- The WTP mobile app will work with no phone reception.



- Speak to your group admin if the site you require does not show.



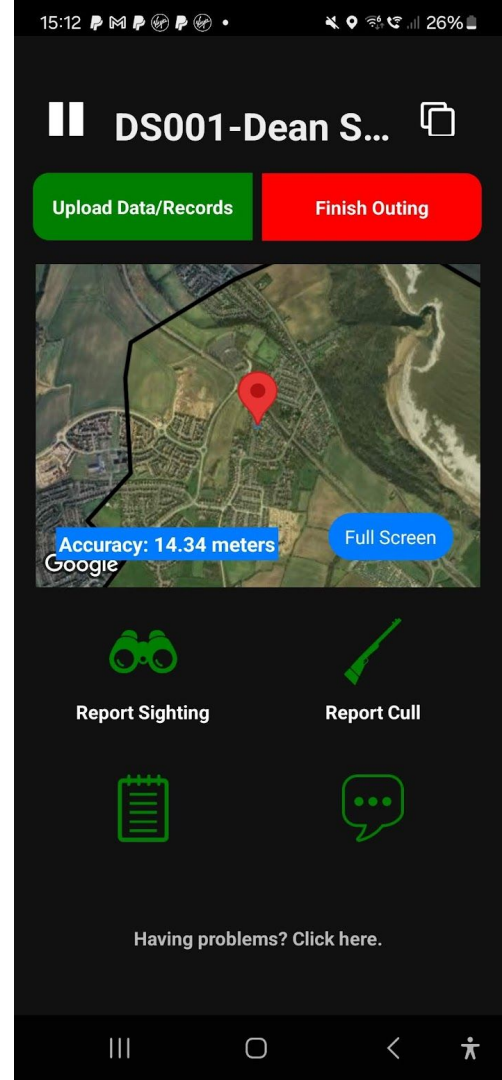

- If you have no reception, you will get a notification to try again later, you can do this back at home over wifi or when you have good mobile reception.

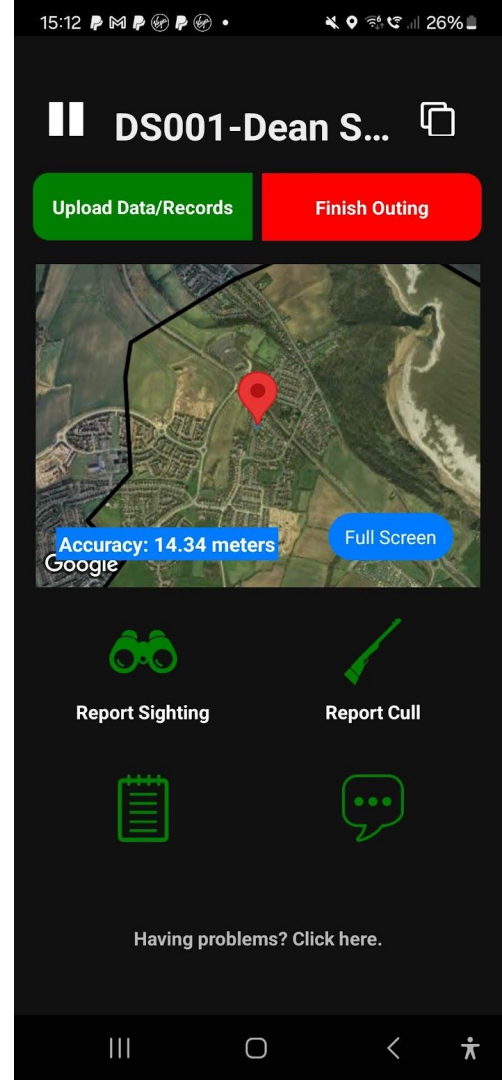
